Treasures From Our Tradition

The second Sunday of Lent every year recalls the Transfiguration of the Lord. Since the fourth century, Mount Tabor has been the focus of devotion to this event. As mountains go, it is not particularly lofty, rising about fifteen hundred feet, within view of the Sea of Galilee and very close to Nazareth. Scripture doesn't identify the mountain, but in the year 348 Saint Cyril of Jerusalem said he preferred Mount Tabor to Mount Hermon as the site of the Transfiguration, and his opinion won. It has long been a strategic military site, and ancient fortresses are visible on the heights. Over the centuries, churches and fortified monasteries rose on the mountaintop, only to be destroyed by various invaders. Six hundred years ago, local Christians started to decorate the ruins with flags and banners on the Feast of the Transfiguration. In 1631, the Sultan granted permission to the Franciscans to live on Mount Tabor, and they have been there ever since, discovering the ruins of an old Crusader church and constructing the present church on the site in 1924.

The top of the mountain is divided into Greek Orthodox and Latin (that's us) zones. At one time, tourists arrived on the summit by bus, but this is no longer permitted. Some ride bicycles up a challenging and winding path, while others take the four thousand three hundred steps constructed for Christian pilgrims in the fourth century. It's hard to imagine the fishermen following Jesus up this craggy mountain without complaint. Visitors will sympathize with Peter's plan to construct booths and stay put with Jesus, Moses, and Elijah for a while, enjoying the view, and planning the trip back down.

The Scrutinies

Members of the R.C.I.A. process in our parish of St. Joseph and our Mission Church of St. Vincent de Paul were presented to our Bishop, the Most. Rev. Jaime Soto at St. Claire Parish, on Saturday, February 17th, in a Rite called the *Rite of Election and The Call To Continuing Conversion*. The catechumens (unbaptized) were accepted for election by the bishop and are now called the “Elect”. The “Elect” will enter into an experience of “purification and enlightenment” (a deeper conversion) by celebrating the “scrutinies” on the 3rd, 4th, and 5th, Sundays of Lent.

On these three Sundays, special texts from the Gospel of John will be proclaimed: ‘the Samaritan Woman,’ ‘the man born blind,’ and ‘the raising of Lazarus from the dead.’ The prayer of the “scrutinies” follows this pattern: invoking all to pray; offering prayers for all the faithful; exorcisms; (i.e., casting out darkness, so as to live as “children of the light”); laying on of hands; and the dismissal blessing of the “Elect” and our candidates -- (our baptized brothers and sisters who are preparing to receive the Sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist) -- to further *Break Open and Reflect on the Word Of God*. Our scrutinies will be prayed after the homily next Sunday, the 3rd Sunday of Lent, at the 9:00 am, and 1pm Mass.

Children's Liturgy of the Word

During the **Sunday Mass** at **9am** and **11am**, volunteers in our parish community offer their time and talent to serve the children ages **4-10** by proclaiming the Word of God to them at their level of understanding. The lector/minister, accompanied by another adult, comes forward to receive the book of the readings from the presider and leads the children from the assembly to a classroom for the sharing of the Word. This usually takes between **15-20 minutes** and the children return to the assembly before the presentation of the gifts.
